Sub: Hajj 2010 – Inoculation against meningitis to Hajj pilgrims of
Tamil Nadu – Programme – Communicated.

We are glad to inform that inoculation programme (against meningitis) for the intending Hajj pilgrims of Tamil Nadu, will be conducted Insha Allah on 22nd and 23rd July 2010 in various inoculation centres. The pilgrims belonging to particular district/places should approach only the centre allotted to them. They should not approach any other centre (except the centre allotted for them), since vaccine would be supplied to a particular centre only according to the number of pilgrims attached to that centre.

2. The details of the places covered, dates on which inoculation camps would be held and name and address of the centres where inoculation camps are proposed to be held are given below:-

We, therefore, request you to report only at the centres allotted to your group alongwith all other members on the dates mentioned in the schedule from 10.00 A.M. to 1.00 P.M. and get yourself inoculated against Meningitis free of cost. Please bring one ml. disposable syringes for every member of your group without fail.

4. As per the terms of World Health Organisation (WHO) guidelines and also as per Saudi Health requirements, children upto the age of 2 years are permitted to accompany their parents for performing Hajj pilgrimage subject to the condition that they are required to get inoculated against Meningitis and produce a certificate to the effect that they have been inoculated which should be carried with them.

5. We request you to utilize the above facility and get vaccination done to avoid inconvenience at the time of departure for Hajj pilgrimage. If you are unable to get the inoculation at any of the centres, you will have to make your own arrangements for vaccination later on.
